- Expense to permit containers on City property
- No space to place bins private property Gastown in particular, but other downtown areas as well.
- Focus should be placed on permitting and planning process to ensure buildings have room for street or reasonable underground access



Cost of Organics

- Organics are significant component of the commercial building waste profile
- Increased expense with organics services since mid 2017
- Communicating on what is and what is not acceptable in public spaces (food courts, malls)
