

Proposals

- Negotiation protocol sent to prospective bidders
- Explicit criteria set out for waste diversion
- 4 proposals received
- Pacific Blasting and Demolition were the successful bidder



Recycling and Waste Management Plan

- Burning and burying prohibited
- Required to salvage, reuse, divert to recycling or otherwise avoid landfill/incinerator
- Waste audit and proof of delivery of recycled materials
- Dimensional lumber must be deconstructed to preserve the wood for reuse:

Option 1: Stack by size and store where directed by BESI, onsite; or

Option 2: Arrange for resale with deduct from the contracted price
